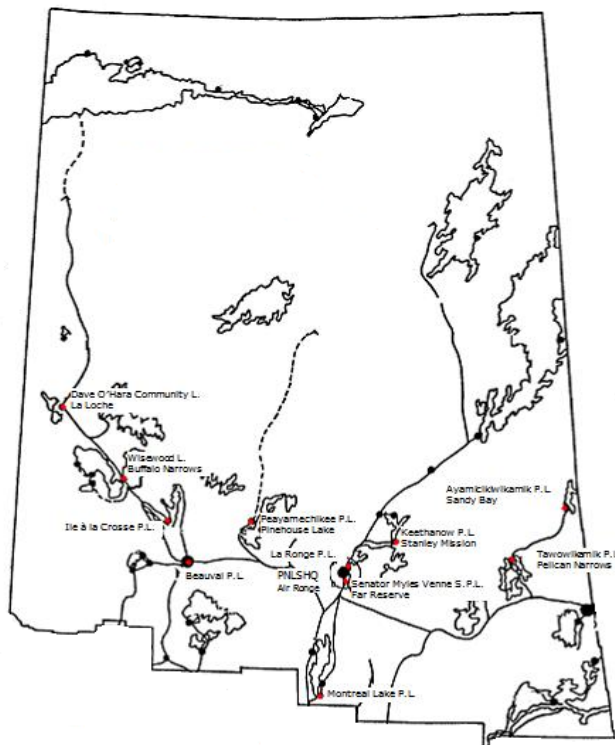
### eBooks

**Library2go** is a virtual library, provided by OverDrive, where you will find a selection of **eBooks** and **Audiobooks** available to download and enjoy on your computer or portable device. **Library2go** can be accessed from our website at [www.pahkisimon.ca](http://www.pahkisimon.ca) (under "Audiobooks & eBooks") or at [library2go.sk.ca](http://library2go.sk.ca).

**TumbleBooks:** Access this service via our website, under Books & Stories — TumbleBookCloud. Stories and poems come alive for the reader, as the actual book is displayed and can be read to the viewer.

**PressReader:** Access this service via our website, under eResources — PressReader. This allows you to read newspapers and magazines from across Canada and around the world.

**NNELS:** The National Network for Equitable Library Services allows a print disabled person to borrow reading materials that they can download to a computer / MP3 player or their iPhone. Patrons must register separately for this service.

# How to Use a Library Card

## How do I get a public library card?

### Register at any public library!

Fill out the yearly registration form at the library.

If you already have a card, all you need to do is renew at the library or call in to verify that all information is accurate.

Once you have a public library card, then you are able to borrow a number of materials from any public library in Saskatchewan.

### Who can get a public library card?

Anybody can get a public library card! Library cards are provided to all patrons who provide two pieces of ID and are Saskatchewan residents.

### How much does it cost to get a library card?

First cards are free. Replacement fees are charged for lost/stolen cards – check with your local public library.

### Library privileges

Be aware of the privileges of borrowing materials. You will need to consent to pay for any lost or damaged materials borrowed under your library card. You will also need to keep your library card account up-to-date and fine-free (if you are over the \$10 limit on fees, you won't be able to borrow materials). If library materials are lost, payment must be made for the full cost of replacing those items before you can renew, borrow/request or place a hold on materials.

### How do I return my library materials?

You can return your library materials at ANY public library in Saskatchewan, or at your local public library.

### How do I use my library card?

You can search and request materials from any public library in the province directly from our website:

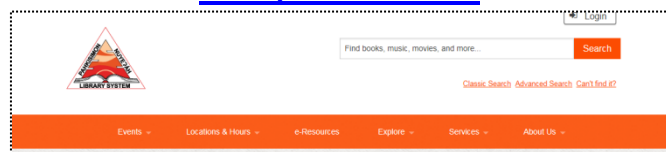

## Have Internet access at home or at work?

You can search and/or request materials directly from our website:

[www.pahkisimon.ca](http://www.pahkisimon.ca)



Just look for the catalogue search box on the top right hand side of the screen! **LOG IN**, or simply put in the title or author. The information that you want will pop up with the closest to your inquiry, just like a Google search.

### Know exactly what materials you are looking for?

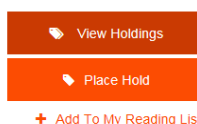
Individual titles can be submitted by logging on to your account (library card number and four-digit PIN)

i.e.: Harry Potter and the half-blood prince,

i.e.: Danielle Steel (all her titles & pseudonyms)

With your public library card, you can request any item in the SILS online catalogue (this is also known as "**placing a hold**").

Once you have located the item(s) you want to borrow, click the corresponding 'Request' or 'Place Hold' icon.



When you request the item, you will be directed a **Request Verification** page. If you are not logged in you will be prompted to enter your library card number and PIN.

Click on **Pickup Location** and select a public library from the drop down menu – the materials will be sent to the public library chosen. **Direct Patrons** (anyone living in the PNLs service area but in a community without a public library) will select PNLs, and the materials/items will be sent to PNLs headquarters and then mailed to the patron.

A message will tell you that your request is complete.

To view requested item(s) in your account, click on **Return to Your Record** in the top right corner of the screen. This allows you to see what you have out, what you have re-requested, and the status. You may also keep a list of the items that you have read in your reading history. (This option needs to be selected in your library record/profile.)

### When materials arrive at your public library...

A notice will be sent to your email address (if this was chosen as the way you want to be contacted), or an automated telephone voice message, announcing that your materials are ready for pick up at your library. Go to the library and check them out.

### Looking for materials on a subject, or a class set?

Send a **Subject Request** form to our office! PNLs will search through our materials and send you a selection of materials in a variety of formats. Class set title requests can be sent on Subject Forms; indicate if a teacher guide is also required. Just fill out a request form and submit via fax or email.
