

chairperson's Report

As I'm sure it must be for so many of us these days, it feels strange and distant now to reflect on the previous calendar year, back before the arrival and spread of the now-global COVID-19 pandemic. All of us within the Pahkisimon Nuye?áh Library System extend our deepest condolences to those across our region and around the province who have lost loved ones in this continuing pandemic, and we will continue to provide our member communities with all of the service and support that is possible under the circumstances as they evolve.

When remembering the year 2019, one of the first and most memorable recollections that comes to mind is the historically severe winter that we all faced throughout the start of the year, with February in particular entering the Saskatchewan record books as the coldest in forty years. 


