

## chairperson's Report

First and foremost, on behalf of all library staff and board trustees across the Pahkisimon Nuye?áh Library System, we send our deepest sympathies and condolences to all northerners who have lost family, friends, and loved ones to COVID-19. The continuing pandemic has been an incredibly stressful and challenging time for everyone across the North, and our hearts go out to all who have felt its impact.

2021 was the first full calendar year of COVID-19 and its wide-ranging impacts on society, and the strange and unusual circumstances of the worsening pandemic created many disruptions for our library system, for our region, and all across the province.

Our Northern Reading Program, which normally runs in all northern schools and communities through the months of January and February, had to be altered to reflect the chaotic nature of the pandemic in 2021 as member schools and school libraries all across the North navigated reopening, closing, or moving to remote learning depending on their local conditions.

The 2021 Northern Saskatchewan Archives Open House and 2021 Annual General Meeting were both unable to take place as scheduled, and the 2021 TD Summer Reading Club moved to a hybrid model to reflect the wide differences in service availability from community to community. PNLS Headquarters was also closed for two weeks, September 13 through 24, due to a positive COVID-19 case within the office. (The staff member, thankfully, recovered.)

We send our thanks to the Saskatchewan Ministry of Education for their internet connection upgrades to the provincial CommunityNet (CNet) system, which were completed partway through the year and which allowed us to host our first-ever all-online PNLS Northern Library Conference in October of 2021. The 2021 NLC was an outstanding success, and we thank all contributors and partners who made this event and all other programming throughout the year possible.

All libraries large and small are powered by the caring, hardworking people who make their services and supports possible, and we extend our endless thanks and appreciation to all member library and member school staff across the North. I also want to thank the excellent staff of PNLS Headquarters in Air Ronge for their service and diligence over this past year, and to send very special congratulations to PNLS Assistant Director Harriet Roy on her upcoming retirement later in this year. Please join me in thanking Harriet Roy for her incredible work across her amazing career.

All of our libraries, schools and communities have dealt admirably with the great strain of the pandemic's ongoing challenges and dangers, and have done remarkable work to keep services running and morale as high as possible. I know that everyone across our region will continue to do everything we can to keep each other safe and secure through this challenging time, and I know that all of us look forward to a day when the pandemic is no longer a factor in our daily lives. Until then, and as always, *The Pahkisimon Nuye?áh Library System will lead the North to information*.




