#### **5.2.3 HQ Stacks Lighting Modifications Planning**

Linda has been trying to get an updated quote from Mid-City. The original quote had the change of the lights, and a second quote was to drop the lights to a more manageable height. Currently the lights are about 40 feet in the air, and it would be dropped to about 15 feet.

have a minimum high school diploma, so we will be updating the salary scale to remove that line.
