5.4 PNLS 2023 Annual Budget Discussion and Approval Motion

James went over the PNLS budget and explained each section. The vehicle was purchased last year.

The Materials Grant will be at \$25,000 as in previous years.

The third year of the Sask Power NRP grant was this year, so we will need to reapply.

Travel has gone a lot because of the increase in provincial rates. There is an extra in the Maintenance exceptions due to the fire panel damage.

The audit is expected to go up by at least 5 to 15 percent. Some of the computers at the library will need to be updated, especially since Polaris will be going to the cloud and will require Windows 11. We will possibly need to change the receipt printers as well.

The photocopier is near the end of the lease, and we will need to decide whether to upgrade or buy out the current printer. Payroll is a little lower, but contracts will be a bit higher. Harriet will be coming on to do some training, and workbee work. The potential of Lisa becoming the Assistant Director and the payroll for her and Roseanne will still be lower than what was being paid to Harriet.

The increase to the minimum wage will be adjusted in October.
