# 2024 SaskPower Northern Reading Program: Uniting Communities Through Reading



The SaskPower Northern Reading Program, hosted by the Pahkisimon Nuye'áh Library System, successfully united communities across Northern Saskatchewan in a celebration of literacy and shared love for books during January and February 2024. This initiative featured distinct weekly themes and a range of contests, fostering community engagement and creativity.

## **Program Highlights:**

Weekly Themes: Throughout the program, participants explored unique weekly themes, such as
celebrating family literacy, exploring local history, and highlighting tales of compassion and kindness,
enriching their reading experiences and broadening their understanding of diverse subjects. Weekly
themes included links to recommended reading lists on the PNLS website.

### **Contests and Creative Engagement:**

- Reading Challenge: Participants logged their reading minutes, competing for the title of "Readingest Community." and the opportunity to win prize packs.
- Writing Contest: This contest provided a platform for participants of all ages to express their creativity in various literary forms.
- Colouring Contest: Open to all ages, this contest gave participants the opportunity to showcase their artistic talents and win books and personalized letters from Wandering Willie, enhancing engagement and providing fun for every participant.
- Bulletin Board Contest: Teachers and libraries crafted bulletin boards that promoted the Northern Reading Program, fostering a visual celebration of reading and helping to spread the word about the program's benefits and activities.
- Community and School Participation: Notably, Canoe Narrows was celebrated as this year's reading champions, demonstrating strong community involvement.
- **Digital Engagement and Accessibility:** With a new online presence, the program reached an even wider audience, especially beneficial for participants in remote areas, online students, and homeschoolers.
- Anticipated Changes for 2025: Based on participant feedback, the 2025 SaskPower Northern Reading Program will feature revised registration divisions for classroom teachers, school and public libraries, and the general public, more precise reading guidelines to make help make tracking reading minutes more manageable and enriching, enhanced prizes to further incentivize participation, and an improved digital leaderboard to make tracking progress more interactive and engaging. These updates aim to enhance user experience and celebrate the reading achievements across Northern Saskatchewan.

If I Ever Get Out of Here by Eric Gansworth offers an engaging look at the challenges and friendships of Lewis Blake, a Native American teenager in the 1970s. Set against a backdrop of racial tensions, Lewis's story unfolds in a predominantly white high school where his bond with George, a military kid who loves music, bridges their cultural divides. This novel enhances classroom discussions on social inclusion and the resilience needed to overcome adversity. Unlike Sherman Alexie's The Absolutely True Diary of a Part-Time Indian, which focuses on humorous and poignant moments of life on the reservation, Gansworth's work delves into cross-cultural friendships and the solace found in shared interests, presenting a different layer of Native American experiences in educational settings.
