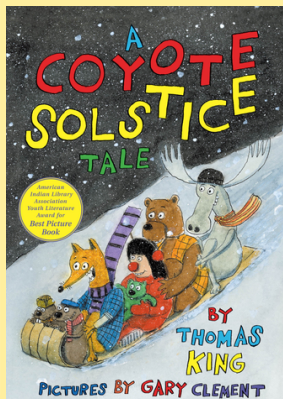
December Highlights
