7.1 Headquarters Staffing, Recruitment and Contract Updates 7.1.1 PNLS Headquarters Summer Student Position

We had a summer student start in June for a period of 8 weeks. Amanda has been doing very well. Her contract has been extended for two weeks, to cover off vacation days for Serena.

7.1.2 La Ronge & Area Family Literacy Hub Funding Transfer

We have received 60% of the \$64,500 funds for the Literacy Hub. There was also an additional \$5,000 received for a one time grant for First Nations and Metis Family Outreach.

There are new passports available for the Notice Nature program. There are a lot of activities, prizes and information booklets available. We are looking at translating some of the booklets to Cree and Dene.
